





Project Location

- Unsafe access to bus stops
- No sidewalks
- No crosswalk ramps
- WSSC impacts in roadway

- Bus stop pad provided
- Full corridor connectivity
- ADA compliant crossings
- Avoids utilities (poles/hydrants)

- ~ 4,100 feet of Sidewalk
- 7 Bus Stop Pads
- 14 ADA-Compliant Sidewalk Ramps
- 115 Street Trees to be planted
- ½ acre of Woodland Reforestation
- Six (6) Bioswales
