Help Us Maintain Our Voter Rolls

Do you receive election mail for someone no longer at your address? Please, don't ignore it!

Write "Not At This Address" and put the mail back in your mailbox.

Because we live in a City where a large number of registered voters are temporary residents, you play a vital role in helping with voter list maintenance. Please don't ignore or toss that misdirected mail. Instead, each time you receive mail for a voter that doesn't live there, mark it "Not At This Address" and put it back in your mail box.

The Post Office will return the mail to the Board of Elections which will begin the process of updating our voter rolls. The Board of Elections uses returned mail delivery as one method to maintain up-to-date addresses.

Voter registration is governed by the National Voter Registration Act of 1993 (also referred as "Motor Voter") and State laws. These laws define the process and data sources that can be used to update and/or cancel voter registration records.
